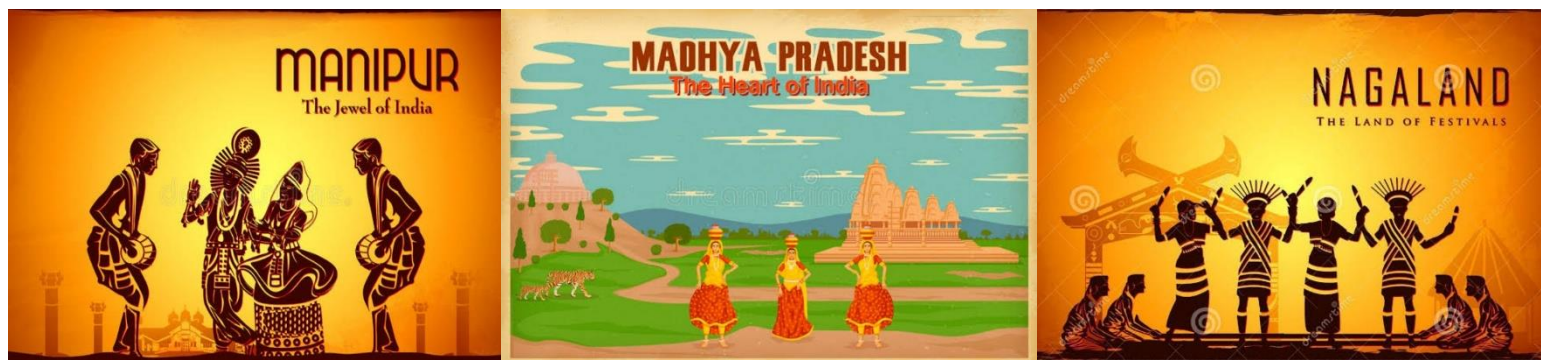

Students were motivated to plant saplings and nurture them to take a step towards conserving nature. Students also learnt about the important and special plants and trees of paired states.



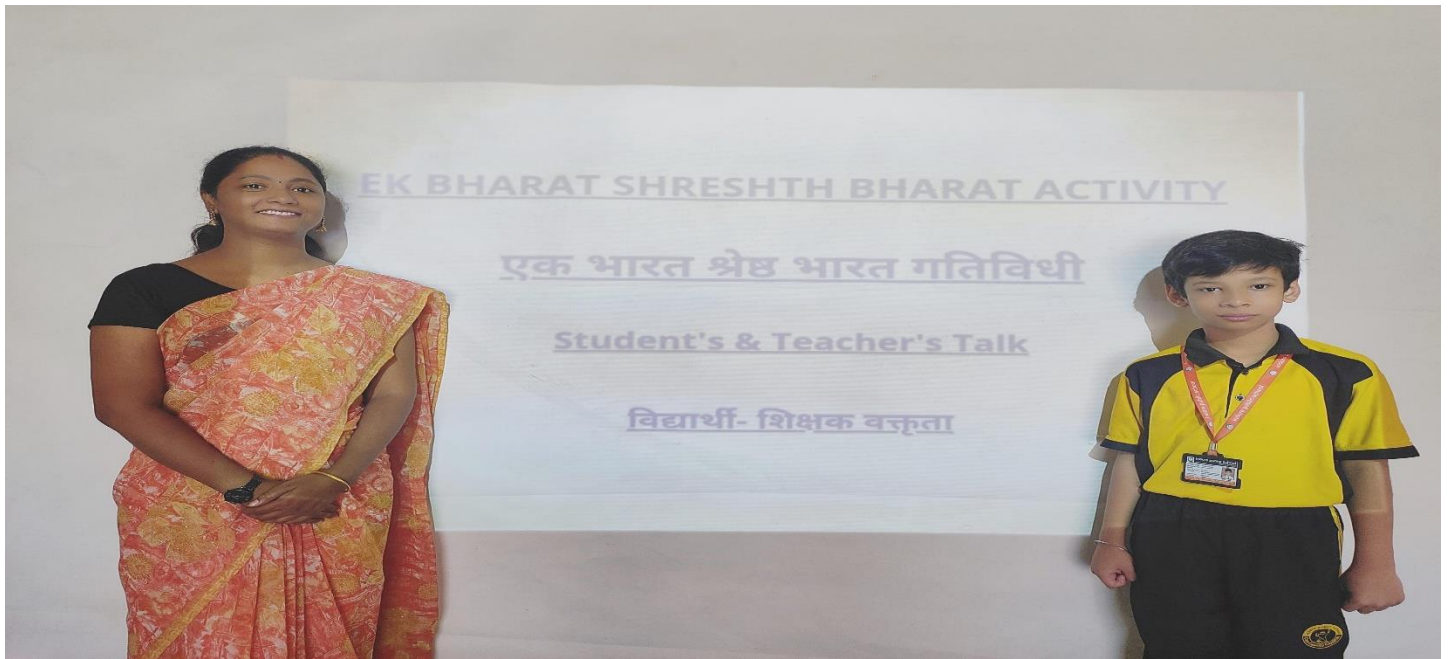
3. Jal Shakti Abhiyan

This activity comes under Jal Shakti Abhiyan in which students learnt about the traditional methods of Jal Sanchay or water storage of Manipur and Nagaland called Jalkund and Zabo respectively. Indore public school Eastern Campus's social science and science faculties briefed the students about the Drip irrigation and made models of above . Soul motive of this activity is integration of awareness and sensitivity towards environment.



4. Talk time

Students were informed about cultural and regional facts which were incredible and unknown regarding the Manipur and Nagaland. This information was given by our Nodal Officer and selected students.

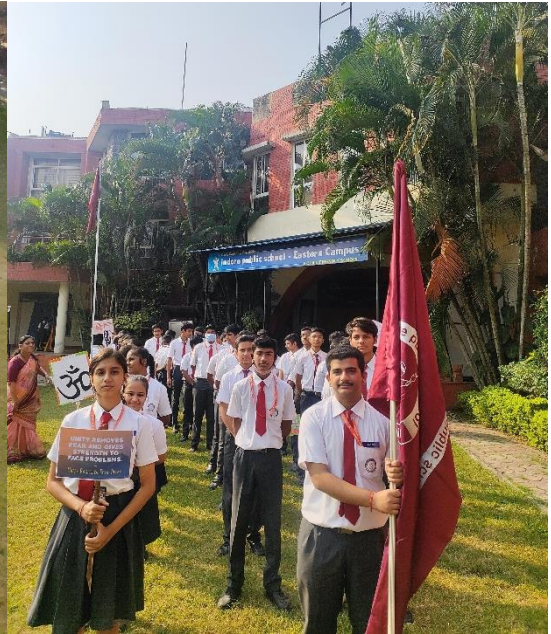
9. Indigenous Sports : Khelo Pcheda
